Digital Learning Activities – For Week 2

PLEASE READ TO YOUR CHILD TEN MINUTES EACH DAY AND HAVE THEM DRAW A PICTURE OF THEIR FAVORITE PART OF THE STORY

Please choose at least 3 different activities per day to complete with your child.

Draw a picture about your day. Ask a parent for help to label your picture.	Observe the weather. Draw a picture of what the weather is like.	Roll two dice. Count the number of dots altogether.	Create flat shapes with toothpicks. Have a parent take a picture of your shapes and upload onto seesaw or email to your teacher.	Make a pattern with your crayons. Describe your pattern. Make two more patterns and describe.	Take strips of paper and tape to a table. Practice cutting off pieces. Make sure to clean up your mess!
Make a collage using different materials that you can find around your house.	Go on a shape hunt in your kitchen. Draw the shapes that you find. Ask a parent to help you label your picture.	Take a nature walk. Make this checklist for your child to use and check off if you find the item. Tree, Grass, Ant, Leaf, bird, squirrel, flower, acorn, cloud, branch.	Go to the Cincinnati Zoo Facebook Page at 3:00 pm EDT. They will showcase one amazing animal. After viewing draw a picture of the animal that you saw.	Watch the Storybots video on youtube. Chose the letter Tt. Look around your house and write down the items that start with the letter T. Count the items on your list.	Paint a picture using cotton swabs.
Thread cheerios or any ring cereal on string, yarn, pipe cleaner or straw.	Make a list of “in” family words. Ex: Fin, tin	Make edible glitter. Take 1 cup sugar and put in Ziploc bag. Add 8-10 drops of food color. Transfer to a baking sheet.	Write a sentence using words that begin with the same letter. Ex: Penny peacock eats pickles in the park.	Do ten jumping jacks, touch your toes 10 times and hop on one foot ten times.	Thinking about the work “under” make a list of how many items you can crawl under.

		Bake in a 350-degree oven, let cool. When cooled, break up any clumps.			
Thinking of the word "Over" make a list of the things that you can jump over.	Write you name in upper- and lower-case letters.	Make a list of your favorite foods.	Count out 20 pieces of any small items ex. Buttons, marshmallows, cereal etc.	Make a list of "og" family words. Example – Log, Frog	Make up a story and tell it to your dog or cat.
